 - explanation of the project's significance, specifying its original contribution to scholarship and/or public policy
 - in-depth description of data sources and methodology
 - brief description of how you may contribute to CCIS activities, including participating in current research projects/conferences, organizing panels/conferences/research projects, teaching at UCSD, publishing through CCIS outlets
 - 1-2 page bibliography on your research topic
 - The proposal cannot exceed 3,000 words (excluding bibliography) and should be double-spaced, with one-inch margins.

PROVIDE **ONE COPY** OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS:

(Applicants for Guest Scholar status do not need to send in these materials)

Three recommendation letters. They can be sent individually by your professors, enclosed with your application materials in envelopes with a signature over the seal, or sent as a dossier. Only original, signed letters will be accepted. Letters should be written in English

One copy each of no more than two of your publications or unpublished papers that relate directly to the proposed research project. Predoctoral applicants may submit one or two dissertation chapters.
